Chief Master Sergeant Michael Nolan is the Senior Enlisted Leader of the 17th Communications Squadron, Goodfellow AFB, Texas. He leads 146 Total Force Airmen to install, operate, maintain, secure, and defend cyber and communications networks and information systems supporting the 17th Training Wing. He leads the squadron's enlisted force and serves as the principal advisor to the commander on all issues concerning morale, health, welfare, training, readiness, effective utilization, and career progression of Airmen. The 17th Communications Squadron provides world-class mission assurance that enables the training of more than 14,000 joint and coalition Intelligence, Surveillance & Reconnaissance, Scientific Applications, and Fire Protection professionals annually.

Chief Nolan enlisted in the Air Force in June 2002. Upon completion of basic training, he attended and graduated from the Air Force's C4 Planning and Implementation Management Technical Training Course in October 2002. He has held joint force management, supervisory, and leadership positions in the communications and cyberspace career fields at the squadron, wing, Major Command, and joint headquarters levels.
